6. Fees will be payable in full at the beginning of each month (within the 1st to the 5th of each month).
7. Fees are currently set at £30 per month per child. Late payment (later than 5 days after the 1st of the month) will incur a £5 administration fee.
8. Fees payable by cash or bank transfer. Bank details will be provided.

Holidays.
